

We Have Been Given the Boldness of Christ

- 1Sam 17:45* You come to me with a sword and with a spear, and with a shield, but I come to you in the Name of the Lord of Hosts, the God of the armies of Israel.
- 1Sam 17:47* All this assembly shall know that the Lord saves not with sword or spear, for the battle is the Lord's and He will give you into our hands.
- 2Kings 7:9* This day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we wait till morning some mischief will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the King's household.
- Ps 68:11* The Lord gave the Word, and great was the company of those that published it.
- Ps 110:3* Your people shall be willing in the day of Your power.
- Ps 138:3* When I cried to You, You answered me, and made me bold with strength in my soul.
- Pro 3:26* The Lord will be your (strong) confidence and will not allow your foot to be caught.
- Pro 14:26* In the fear of the Lord is strong confidence, and His children have a place of refuge. The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, to avoid the snares of death.
- Pro 28:1* The righteous are as **bold** as a lion. (*Rev 5:5*. The Lion of the Tribe of Judah.)
- Is 40:9* O Zion, (the Gospel Church), who brings good tidings, get up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, (God's people), who brings good tidings, lift up your voice with strength, lift it up be not afraid, say to the cities of Judah, (where we live), "Behold your God."
- Is 41:15,16* Behold, I will make you into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth, you shall thresh the mountains
and beat them small, and make the hills like chaff. You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them. You shall rejoice in the Lord, and glory in the Holy One of Israel.
- Is 42:13* The Lord goes forth like a mighty man, (in me). He stirs up His zeal like a man of war, (in me). He cries out, yes, shouts aloud, (in me). He prevails over His enemies, (through me).
- Is 44:8* Fear not neither be afraid: have not I told you from that time, and have declared it? you are even My witnesses. Is there a God beside Me? Yes, there is no God. I know not any.
- Is 49:2* He has made my mouth like a sharp sword, in the shadow of His hand He has hidden me.
- Mic 3:8* Truly I am full of power by the Spirit of the Lord, and of justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.
- Mic 5:8,9* The remnant of Jacob, (the committed core), is like a lion among the beasts of the forest, like a young lion among the flocks of sheep, who if he passes through, treads down and tears in pieces, and none can deliver. Your hand shall be lifted up against your adversaries, and all your enemies shall be cut off.
- Mat 10:19,20* But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what you shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what you shall speak.
For it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you.
- Lk 12:12* For the Holy Spirit shall teach you in the same hour what you ought to say.
- Ac 4:13* When they saw the **boldness** of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. Then they realised that they had been with Jesus.

- Ac 4:29-31* Now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant to your servants, that with all boldness they may speak your Word, by stretching forth your hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of the Holy Child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken, where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the Word of God with boldness.
- Ac 8:4,5* Therefore they that were scattered abroad went everywhere preaching the Word. Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached Christ to them.
- Ac 11:21* And the hand of the Lord was with them. A great number believed and turned to the Lord.
- Ac 18:9,10* Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not your peace. For I am with you, and no man shall set on you to hurt you: for I have much people in this city.
- 1Cor 2:4* The words we speak are not with persuasive words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Holy Ghost and power.
- Eph 3:12* In Whom (Christ), we have **boldness**....
- Eph 6:18,19* Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching with all perseverance and supplication for all saints, and for me that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly, as I ought to speak.
- 1Thes 2:2* We were **bold** in our God to speak to you the Gospel.
- 1Thes 1:8* For from you sounded out the Word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith towards God is spread abroad.
- 2Tim 1:7* God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and a sound mind (full of truth).
- Heb 4:16* Let us therefore come **boldly** to the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in the time of need.
- Heb 10:19* Therefore, brethren, having **boldness** to enter the Holiest by the Blood of Jesus.
